Pampa Regional Medical Center hosted a reception in the Hospital ER to honor the area's first responders to include EMS and Firefighters.

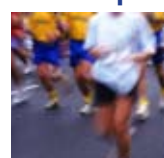
Area Relay for Life to Benefit American Cancer Society
